Declaration of health insurance obligation of students according to § 199a SGB V for the summer semester 2021

I confirm that I was informed that

- If I enter Germany during the above-mentioned semester, I am obligated to get retrospectively a German health insurance for the entire duration of the above-mentioned semester or on the day of enrollment or re-registration.
